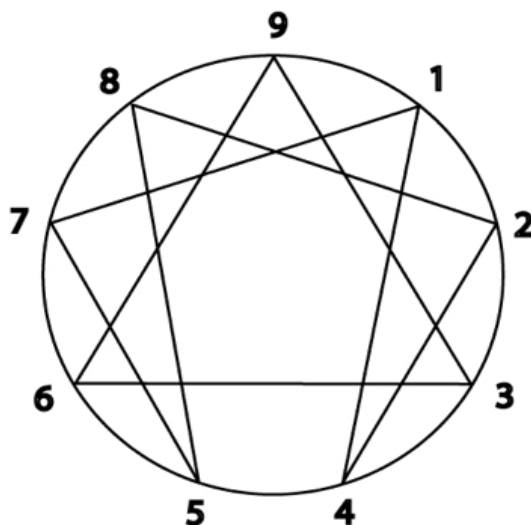

## What is the Enneagram?

The Enneagram is a personality theory that combines the insights of modern psychology with the proven wisdom of the past. According to the Enneagram, there are 9 basic kinds of personalities. Each of these types is described by a set of observable behavioral characteristics and is distinguished by a basic motivation. This introductory workshop will focus on the uniqueness and giftedness of each individual. Learning is facilitated by practical examples, humor, and group dynamics. You will be guided through key concepts of the theory that will assist you in discovering your own type. Implications for building better relationships will be explored.
