ST. VINCENT de PAUL

On a recent Saturday morning, a gentlemen was waiting at the Chapel for the Vincentians. He asked for help and was put on the following Saturday's list. When the two Vincentians arrived the next week, he welcomed them into his apartment. He told them that this month's regular money order rent payment to CMHA had been lost, and he had been given notice to pay immediately or vacate his apartment. He said that he had been with CMHA for many years and had never missed a payment in nine years. His income was just enough to cover monthly bills, but, he assured them, he had never had to ask for financial help before.

He thanked the Vincentians for the nice mattress he had gotten years ago, and wondered if he could have a sofa and a few household items. He was also grateful for a new Bible. Besides giving him vouchers, they promised to contact CMA to cover the lost money; he offered to repay them if the money was found, but they told him to save it for a possible future crisis. He led them in a beautiful prayer, thanking God for all he had and for their visit. The two left there touched by the man and grateful for the funds they could share with him.
