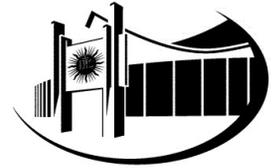

## ST. VINCENT DE PAUL

What if you didn't have the means to bury your mother? Recently, while making a home visit, members of our parish listened to the painful story of this family. The woman's mother had died ten days earlier, but remained at the county morgue because the woman did not have enough money to pay for the burial. She was despondent that, despite the fact that she and her husband were both working full time, she could not pay the nearly \$6000 necessary to properly bury her mother. They needed all of their income to take care of their three beautiful children and themselves. Like so many of our neighbors, they had no extra income.

The Bellarmine Conference owned a burial plot that had been donated to it several years ago by a generous parishioner. The SVDP conference of Bellarmine assigned the burial rights to this plot to the woman's mother. The rest of the expenses were provided by Bellarmine Chapel and various organizations within Xavier University. Together they were able to provide for the burial of this woman's mother.

At the end of a home visit, the woman offered a beautiful thanks to God for bringing the Bellarmine Conference of St. Vincent de Paul to her, allowing her to finally bury her mother properly. Sometimes the question, "What must I do," challenges us to do what at first might seem impossible. The community of Bellarmine and Xavier working together, however, found the answer.
