

### **DR. MARCIE LENK LECTURE**

*Truth and Faith: Can Jews and Christians Really Open Ourselves to the Truth of Each Other?*

Tuesday, October 23, 7:00 PM in Kennedy Auditorium, Room 412

For most of history, most Jews and Christians have rejected the possibility that we have anything to learn from each other's faith and religion. We will examine the history of this rejection as well as recent changes of attitudes among both Christian and Jewish religious leaders, and consider the opportunities and limitations of interfaith dialogue and understanding.
