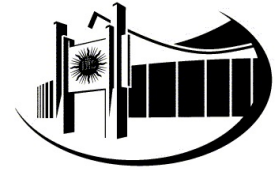

### THE SPIRITUAL EXERCISES

Week of Prayer #22 "Jesus as Human and Divine"

This week you take more risk, you trust more in the human-ness of Jesus by going deeper into your own human-ness. You may be at the brink of deep healing like the widow's son or like Lazarus. You have an inner sense of what needs to be made whole, to be restored to life. The love of Christ is there for you in the most painful places. Notice any fear and give it to Christ, the one who is sent just for this purpose.

You may be at the margin of something new, an invitation not felt before, like Peter, but it's happening and you can't deny it. Here is the Anointed One saying your name. Begin to say a deeper yes to joining Jesus as human and divine, just as you discover and touch your own human life and your own divine life. It is a being chosen and a choosing.

Our dedicated volunteers provide meals, activities and crafts for the children and families, overnight chaperones and other help with setting up and cleaning up at the hosting church. More volunteers are always needed. This is a wonderful ministry for families with children because the children can come along and interact with the IHN children and learn about serving others.

Right now IHN has a pressing need for new or gently used bath towels and bath mats for the guests to use at the day center.
